

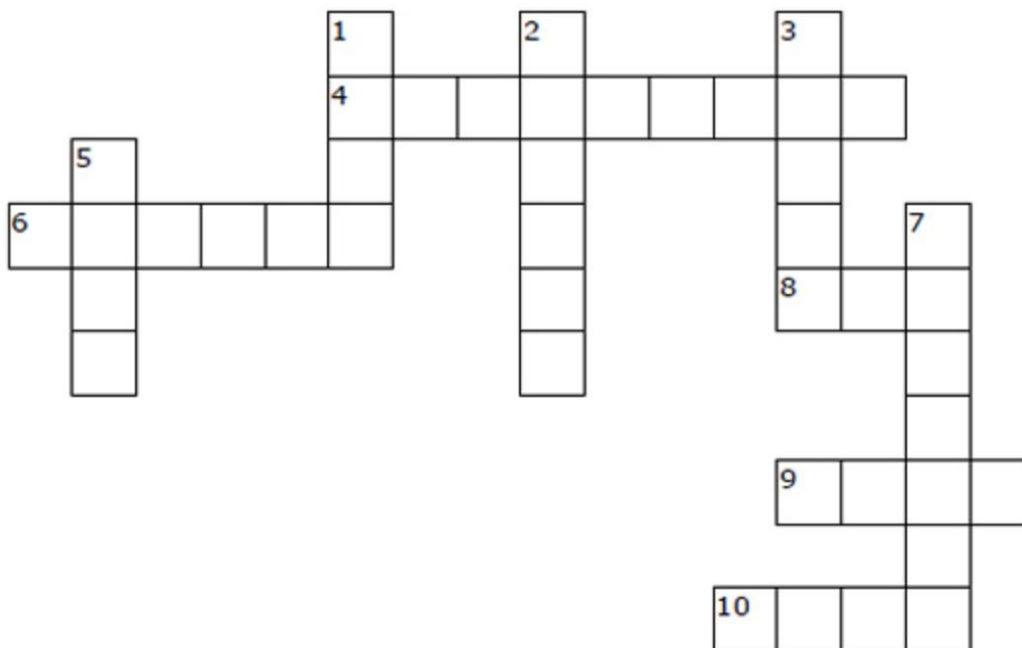

This sheet is suitable for all ages and especially those who are looking for something simple and interactive this Sunday.

A Reading from Scripture for this week: Epiphany

The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, 'Follow me.' Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter. Philip found Nathanael and said to him, 'We have found him about whom Moses in the law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus son of Joseph from Nazareth.' Nathanael said to him, 'Can anything good come out of Nazareth?' Philip said to him, 'Come and see.' When Jesus saw Nathanael coming towards him, he said of him, 'Here is truly an Israelite in whom there is no deceit!' Nathanael asked him, 'Where did you come to know me?' Jesus answered, 'I saw you under the fig tree before Philip called you.' Nathanael replied, 'Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!' Jesus answered, 'Do you believe because I told you that I saw you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than these.' And he said to him, 'Very truly, I tell you, you will see heaven opened and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man.'

John 1.43-51

Ideas of things to talk about based on this Scripture:

- When John saw Jesus coming, he called out 'Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!' Nathanael calls him 'Rabbi', which means 'Teacher'. He also calls him a king. Others when they meet Jesus say: 'We have found the Messiah!' (The Hebrew word 'Messiah' means the same thing as the Greek word 'Christ'). Jesus was called many things by those who followed him. What do you think you would call Jesus if you saw him for the first time, like the disciples?
- In the gospel today, we see Jesus starting to put together his team. Philip hears Jesus say, 'Come with me' and he goes and finds his friend Nathanael, inviting him to 'Come and see' as well. Why do you think Jesus gathers these people? Why do you think Philip was so eager to follow Jesus? Why was Nathanael a bit hesitant? What do you think Nathanael might have done if Philip hadn't been there to encourage him? Who can you offer encouragement to today?

bring us with the whole creation
to your glory, hidden through past ages
and made known in Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

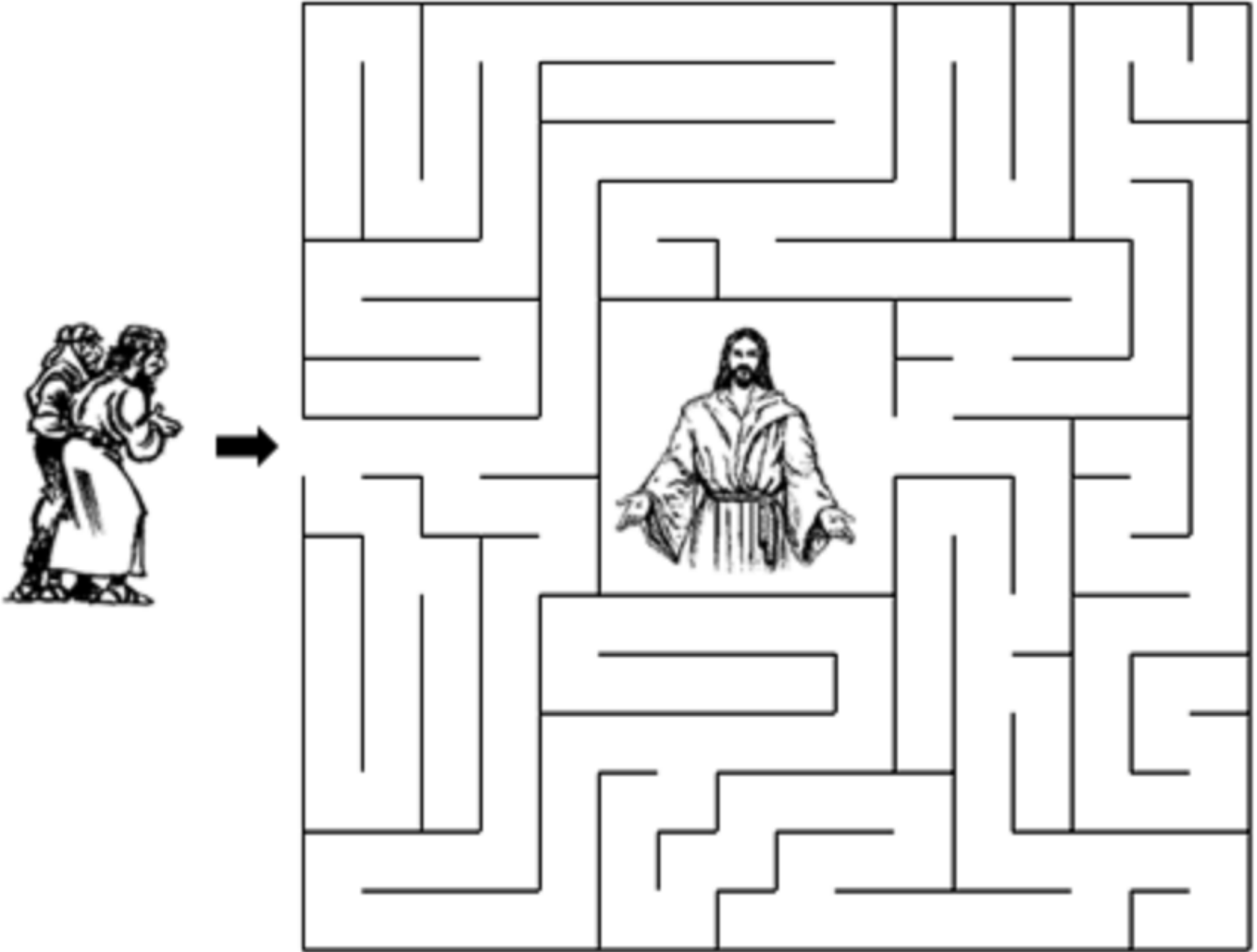
